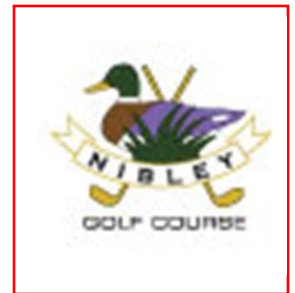
Registration deadline for this event is August 9, 2012
